SCHOOLS ARE PERMITTED TO ENTER A MAXIMUM OF 6 RUNNERS PER CATEGORY (MINIMUM 4 RUNNERS NEEDED FOR THE TEAM EVENT).

All participating teams should have registered on the SSFT website and each age group should have been entered separately (6 Boys, 6 Girls for each year group category). NB: 1 ticket = 1 Team

Changing Facilities:

There are no changing facilities on site, therefore all runners should arrive changed.

Course

Pleased find course map enclosed. The course will be marked with barrier tape and races led by the Hare. It is the responsibility of the competitors to ensure that they complete the correct course. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

Spikes or study may be worn but competitors are advised that there is a short distance crossing the bridge where concrete will be underfoot and can be slippery.

Clothing

It is recommended that competitors run in shorts and T-shirt/polo top. Tracksuits or warm clothing and a waterproof should be worn before and after the competition to avoid injury. Runners should also come equipped with plenty of water to drink.

Funnel

There will be two separate funnels, one for boys and one for girls. These will be clearly marked by pink and blue balloons. Please inform your runners to be aware. **NO OVERTAKING IN THE FUNNEL PLEASE.**

Team Managers

Upon arrival at the event, please report promptly to the hut to sign in and collect your envelopes. Please arrive in plenty of time for the first race.

* Ensure that results (with schools, children's names and numbers written clearly and <u>totalled up</u>) are sent directly to the scoring hut once you have completed the necessary information and <u>immediately</u> after each race is finished. The Scorers need to add up and collate the results into the correct order ready for the Presentations asap. Any delay in handing in your scores will mean a longer wait for everyone and may result in your school not being included in the overall table.*
